

FUND FOR ENCOURAGING PEOPLE WITH DEMENTIA TO ATTEND ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE IN BERLIN

Alzheimer's Disease International has set up a small fund from a couple of anonymous donations from people with dementia.

Who is eligible to apply?

The fund is open to:

- 1) People with dementia that are supported by their national Alzheimer association.
- 2) People with dementia that have not attended an ADI Conference before.
- 3) People with dementia that have not received an ADI bursary before.

Support available

- A travel and accommodation bursary of US \$500
- An early bird registration fee. (Please note the registration fee for Berlin has been especially reduced and will be Euro 65 for a PWD or a family carer.)

Process for applications

If you are interested in applying for this financial assistance to attend the ADI conference you need to:
